


SAVES FOR GAVIN



With the cost of a transplant often exceeding \$500,000.00, many transplant patients are unable to shoulder the financial burden of such a procedure. The Children's Organ Transplant Association (COTA) is a national charity dedicated to organizing and guiding communities in raising funds for transplant-needy patients. In Bergen County, volunteers are raising funds for transplant patients like local baby Gavin Scimeca.

Born on June 4, 2010, Gavin was diagnosed with Autosomal Recessive Polycystic Kidney Disease (ARPKD), and doctors at New York Presbyterian Hospital in New York City are recommending a life-saving kidney transplant. Gavin is the son of River Vale Police Officer Anthony Scimeca and his wife Tara. The Scimeca family needs an estimated \$100,000 to pay their out-of-pocket transplant-related expenses.

Sean McCann, a senior goalkeeper on the Park Ridge High School Soccer Team, is raising money for COTA in honor of Gavin Scimeca. He is seeking pledges for the saves that he makes during his senior season. In Sean's junior year, he made 102 saves. The PRHS soccer season will begin in September and end in October. Sean will send out updates throughout the season via e-mail to track his progress and he'll post details at www.COTAforGavinS.com. All funds raised will go towards transplant-related expenses.
