

**Work Session Minutes – March 23, 2010**

Mayor opened meeting at 8:25pm immediately after the public hearing on the dais.

Eve Mancuso, PE gave her report: maps received from Census Bureau, corrected and returned....

1<sup>st</sup> Stage of No. Fifth Street going out to bid...scope of work for 2010 Road Improvement sent to Ed Sandve, Borough Administrator of Woodcliff Lake...

Plans complete for Leroy Place, Bergen County Soil approval received and will now meet with residents....

Met with Leggett & Brashears, PE to discuss Mill Pond, Bergen County Mosquito Comm. will excavate and dredge free of cost if Borough will obtain necessary permits (approximately one year to obtain permit), soil samples will be taken to determine if product marketable; Utilities will fund \$21,000 for borings to determine depth.

Borough Administrator discussed Field Fees for 2010, need resolution. Councilman Maguire discussed a discount for non-profit organizations. Councilman Maughan discussed club sports and to exclude clubs made up entirely of Park Ridge residents..Councilman Viola suggested before numbers are tweaked to find out what the reserve loss is.

Need procedure for expenditure of field funds....agreed to use for maintenance of Davies field....borough employees should give status periodically...agreed to spend \$2,100 for chemical applications to fields...Agreed to Option C for Davies Field Maintenance Agreement.

**Field Fee discussion pended for next meeting**

Council authorized bus stop bench in front of 37 Park Avenue to be secured by a grant from NJ DOT. Administrator to refer to Planning Board for review and Police Chief for comment.

Clerk asked for support of Senator Cardinale's new bill, which would permit legal ads on official borough web sites instead of newspapers. Council agreed to have resolution placed on next meeting's agenda.

Council agreed that new planters for downtown were not to be ordered.
