**REPORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY**

**Councilmember Fenwick: Finance Committee:** We had a meeting of the Finance Committee, things are going along well. We are taking a hard look at all the items on the budget and going line by line – we are making good progress and we anticipate having something before the Council in March. I would also like to **thank the DPW** for all of the hard work they have done with all of the recent storms that have been having, and I would also like to **thank the Fire Department and the Police** for all of their hard work with the recent fire on Park Avenue. We really appreciate all of the hard work that the DPW, Police and Fire Department have been doing for us.

**Councilmember Ferguson: Park Avenue Fire:** At approximately 1:04 a.m. on the morning of February 21st, there was a reported structure fire at 66 Park Avenue. Park Ridge Fire Department arrived on scene and went straight to work. They called a second alarm and with the help of Montvale, Woodcliff Lake, River Vale and Hillsdale, the fire was extinguished quickly. There was one minor injury reported, so please let's keep that firefighter in your thoughts. **I would like to thank Chief Tom Lepore, and the entire Park Ridge Fire Department and Park Ridge Police Department and all of the mutual aid towns for their efforts.** While most of us were sleeping, they were out there keeping us all safe. So, thank you all very much for your service. I would also like **to thank the DPW, run by Pete Wayne,** for keeping our streets clean. We've had some crazy weather – this February has been something to remember. In driving around the surrounding towns, you can see how hard these guys work, They are by far, the best in the valley! Thank you, guys.

**Councilmember Cozzi: Library:** We recently had a meeting with the Library and they are upgrading their systems. Currently, the Library is part of a network within Bergen County, where you are able to borrow a book, or anything any Public Library carries, anywhere within the county. They are now actually looking into possibly being able to do this with Rockland County, as well, but on a much smaller level. It is pretty impressive, because in this Library, you can do so much and most people don't even know that. Our little Library has so much to offer. Kudos to Mr. Mintz who does a great job running these meetings, as well as to all of the committee members. They are all volunteers and they are all doing everything with the interest of the town at heart. Even in light of COVID, they are still open. If you need or want something or if you are tired of streaming, they do have cd's – you can get the whole season or seasons of a whole show. They carry everything you might want.

**Councilmember Capilli: Police Department:** A quick public service from the Police Department. They are actively enforcing the Fire Zone up at the Ridgemont Shopping Plaza. FYI: don't park there. **Board of Ed:** The Board of Ed met last night. It was an active meeting with a lot of participants. We are here if there are ways that we can help get those goals accomplished. The Borough is here in whatever capacity we can be of assistance.

**Councilmember Metzdorf: Tri-Boro Food Pantry.** The Tri-Boro Food Pantry needs donations. They accept food products; paper products and they also accept monetary donations. You can drop off your donations on Tuesday and Thursday mornings between the hours of 9:00 and 11:00 a.m. They are always so appreciative! **American Legion:** American Legion Post 153 is in a financial crisis. Their expenses have now exceeded their revenue. Because of COVID, all of their fundraising events have had to be cancelled. Therefore, they are asking for the membership, along with any residents that can do so, to make a tax-deductible donation. Lastly, one of their members, Dick Bozzone, will be celebrating a birthday. I would like to wish him a Happy Birthday!

**Mayor Misciagna: American Legion:** The American Legion have joined together to serve our Service members and local veterans in need. Our Legion is comprised of Veterans, Sons of our Veterans and Women's Auxiliary. They continue to carry on the traditions and practices our founding members have set forth in caring for past and current service members. Their service to our country should be recognized. If anybody can help them through this difficult time, please consider helping them out, no matter what size donation you can send. We are approaching our one-year anniversary of dealing with COVID, we have tried to help our restaurants along and our businesses and we forget about some of these other organizations that are equally important. We will be sure to post on our website the information for all those wanting to help can do so.

**Council President Epstein: Recreation Committee:** The Recreation Committee met for the second time last night and they are getting lots of events up and running, for the upcoming year, that are COVID friendly. **Some of those events:** They will have a Tai-Chi and Meditation Zoom session that will take place this Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:00 p.m. So, if you are looking for a little bit of relaxation and some stretching you can sign up for that. The information is posted on the website. TGA will be hosting a Spring Break Sports Camp during the week of Spring break from April 19<sup>th</sup> through April 23<sup>rd</sup>. It will run from 9:00 to 1:00 at Memorial Field. The flyer is posted on the website. We will have a COVID friendly "Drive-By" with the Easter Bunny. It will be held in the Park Ridge Pool parking lot on Saturday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 3-4:00 p.m. Residents will be able to say hello to the Easter Bunny while remaining in their car and will receive a treat bag of goodies from our Bunny. Lastly, we are still planning on having the Car Show this year in May. We are hoping for another successful event, as we had in September, and are hoping for another good turn-out. Mark your calendars for May 1<sup>st</sup> with a rain date of May 8<sup>th</sup>. The Rec Committee has also solidified concerts for the Summer. So, hopefully, the residents can feel like we are heading back to some sort of normalcy.

**Mayor Misciagna:** In closing, I would like to acknowledge again that we are approaching our one-year anniversary in dealing with COVID. I would like to thank everybody at Borough Hall that pulled together and got us through this. As a community, we will get there and will get to "the finish line" - it is coming. We are probably just a couple of months away from getting very close to what we were all used to. It's been a tough year, but we constantly are reminded that we are from a great community. Just the other night, around 1:00 a.m., we had a bunch of Volunteer Fire Department members were out fighting a structure fire. We are very thankful for them and the Police who helped them. We have so many others that are always out there helping our residents. We had the linemen out there on Christmas day helping to keep us going, the Water Department out with a water main break right around the same time, as well as our roads are always the best in the county! So, it's been a difficult year, but we all have a lot to be very thankful for. So, let's keep that in mind, we will get through this. If anyone needs anything, reach out to Borough Hall. We are trying to make appointments for people that need assistance.


