It warms my heart to see this fine young man stepping at a very young age and participating in something as important as firefighting.

PUBLIC PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

- 1. **Robert Metzdorf** Resident spoke about information going around town about the parking situation at the James. I see that the information said that there has been \$150,000 in parking subsidies to rent parking spots. I would like to ask the finance chair, because when I looked around and through the budget, I could not find any payments made to the James. Can you explain?
 - a. Council President Fenwick, finance chair, stated that in the agreement with the James, which is public record, there is a \$75,000 a year parking subsidy that is provided to the James and unfortunately because that matter is currently in contract, negotiations I cannot discuss it any further at this time. The agreement speaks for itself it's a public record. The language of the agreement is what the agreement says, like I said, there are currently negotiations going on with James in relation to that agreement. I would defer to counsel what those negotiations are, but since they are part of discussions in closed we can't discuss them.
 - b. Mr. Metzdorf asked if any money has been paid out to the James for Parking and Mayor Misciagna stated no there has not been.

- c. Council President Fenwick stated it says subsidies it doesn't say that the town paid you know gave a check for \$150,000. The agreement was that there would be \$75,000 a year in exchange for 70 spaces. The 50 spaces which are permanent spaces that the town could theoretically use but unfortunately there's 20 spaces that the town agreed to pay for that are unusable they're shared with the James. There is no guarantee we or the residents can use those at any time. I would have not agreed to this agreement at the time, I understand why, because there was supposed to be a community center built but it failed through and was not built. The agreement is still there.
- d. Mr. Metzdorf asked if there has been any effort made to rent out those spots? Council President Fenwick stated earlier in this year we actually passed a resolution to go out to bid on the parking spaces and then because of discussions that we had in closed session about some other ideas that I just told you, I unfortunately can't talk because it is in active negotiations. That was put aside and we are currently negotiating with the James on that issue.
