WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("County Trust Fund") Municipal Program for Park Development, provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$528,852.50 from the County Trust Fund to fund the surface improvement, reconstruction, and recreational enhancement to Memorial Park – Davies Field; and;

WHEREAS, the applicant is willing to use the County Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Bergen for the above named project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Park Ridge:

- 1. That it is hereby authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of **May 20, 2019**, as established by the County; and,

FINANCE CHAIRPERSON MICHAEL MINTZ – PRESENTS THE 2019 BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE MUNICIPAL BUDGET. *PRESENTATION CAN BE VIEWED IN FULL AND IS ATTACHED AT THE END OF THESE MEETING MINUTES.

We meet twice a month. We have all of our Department Heads that come in and give us updates on their daily work. Department Heads consists of Bill Beattie, Director of Operations, Christopher O'Leary, Supervisor of Water & Sewers, Paul Longo, Supervisor of Electric, Angelo Dell'Armo is our Project Engineer and Peter Wayne is the Department of Public Works Superintendent. These are the guys that run the town; keep the power and lights on, the water running and the streets clean.

<u>Michael Mintz:</u> At this time I would like to open the floor to the public to anyone that has questions on any of the Budgets.

Speaker #1: Will Fenwick – 5 May Court - I am running for Mayor, for full disclosure, to anybody in attendance this evening. First question – I took a look at the town's website today, and having been to the past several council meetings and being at the meeting where the Budget was introduced, I knew that the Budget Hearing was today. Speaking with the Council at one of the prior meetings, you directed me as to where on the website the Budget would be, where I could find it. But, for the casual user of the website, if you are just going straight to the main page, there is no indication anywhere that the Budget meeting was today. It clearly stated there was a Council meeting tonight, didn't say that the Budget Hearing was today. There is a "News Section" on the website that has a listing of events going on in town, but not the Budget Hearing was listed.

<u>Mayor Misciagna</u>: I hope you are not implying that we were trying to hide the Budget Presentation – Mike has worked very hard on it. We are proud of the Budget and if you couldn't find it, I am sorry to hear that.

<u>Will Fenwick</u>: No, I am not implying that. No, I said, I found it. I asked the Council at the first meeting when I was looking for it, it wasn't on the website. It was then put up on the website. Like I said, it's just for the casual user, it's hard to find. That's just an observation. Maybe in the future you may want to put it in the "News & Events".

<u>Mayor Misciagna</u>: I am actually sorry to hear to that, because we changed our website just this past year to try and make it more user friendly, just for that reason. So, this upsets me to hear that and we will work on it for sure.

Will Fenwick: Thank you.

<u>Michael Mintz</u>: Just so you know - our town, I've been told this by our Auditor, our new Chief Financial Officer, we actually do these presentations from the Council and the members, and other towns don't do it this way. Basically, you have to look up and find out what your budget is. They don't tell you anything and you come to the meeting and they basically recite the number and let you ask questions. So, in this town, we do things differently.

We try to inform the citizens as to what's going on with our budget. We take pride in that, and we have been doing that and it's a long history of Park Ridge. So, your points are well taken, we will make sure that people get to see it next year on the website and get fully notified.

<u>Will Fenwick</u>: Thank you! My next question – If you take a look at the Explanatory Statement and Budget Message within the budget, it indicates that the town utilized the CAP Bank this year. I know that every year the town passes an ordinance allowing for a CAP Bank, but when is the last time the CAP Bank was actually used?

Jeff Bliss: I would say that we probably used a portion of it last year, we didn't use all of it. And probably the year before that we might have used a small portion of it also. Although we've used it in the past, we've always still banked more than we used, and the same happened again this year. We were able to still bank some additional monies that we did not use from the bank.

Will Fenwick: The other questions you answered in the presentations. So, thank you.

<u>Speaker #2 – Lori Fredrics – 5 Duke Court</u>: I would just like to let everyone know that PKRG has been posting about the Budget meeting on our social media. I did tonight on Park Ridge Mom's – we put it on our unofficial Facebook page and we are broadcasting "Live" right now on television, so everybody can see it. I think it's also been on the town bulletin board. I think people are aware of it just from my perspective as a person in attendance here tonight and somcone who is involved in broadcasting it.

Mayor Misciagna/Tom Farinaro/Mike Mintz: Thank you, Lori.

- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and <u>N.J.A.C.</u> 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
- 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate, and correctly stated;
 - b. Items of appropriations are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement, and content the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.

5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced, publicly advertised, and adopted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.

6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, COVENANTING TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED, APPLICABLE TO THE EXCLUSION FROM GROSS INCOME FOR FEDERAL INCOME TAX PURPOSES OF INTEREST ON OBLIGATIONS ISSUED BY THE BOROUGH OF PARK RIDGE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, BOROUGH CLERK, CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER AND OTHER BOROUGH OFFICIALS TO TAKE SUCH ACTION AS THEY MAY DEEM NECESSARY OR ADVISABLE TO EFFECT SUCH COMPLIANCE AND DESIGNATING A \$2,565,700 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTE, DATED MAY 1, 2019, PAYABLE MAY 1, 2020, AS A "QUALIFIED TAX EXEMPT OBLIGATION" PURSUANT TO SECTION 265(b)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen,

New Jersey (the "Borough") from time to time issues bonds, notes and other obligations, the interest on which is excluded from gross income for Federal income tax purposes, and desires to take such action as may be necessary or advisable to establish and maintain such exclusion; and

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WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), contains provisions with respect to the exclusion from gross income for Federal income tax purposes of interest on -2- obligations, including provisions, among others, which require issuers of taxexempt obligations, such as the Borough to account for and rebate certain arbitrage earnings to the United States Treasury and to take other action to establish and maintain such Federal tax exclusion; and

WHEREAS, the Borough intends to issue a \$2,565,700 bond anticipation note, dated May 1, 2019, payable May 1, 2020 (the "Note"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to designate the Note as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) of the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Park Ridge, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Borough Council hereby covenants on behalf of the Borough, to the extent permitted by the Constitution and the laws of the State of New Jersey, to do and perform all acts and things permitted by law and necessary to assure that interest paid on bonds, notes and other obligations of the Borough (including the Note) be and remain excluded from gross income of the owners thereof for Federal income tax purposes pursuant to Section 103 of the Code.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The Mayor, Borough Clerk, Chief Financial Officer and the other officials of the Borough are hereby authorized and directed to take such action, make such representations and give such assurances as they may deem necessary or advisable to effect compliance with the Code.

SECTION 3. The Note is hereby designated as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" for the purpose of Section 265(b)(3) of the Code.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. It is hereby determined and stated that (1) said Note is not a "private activity bond" as defined in the Code and (2) the Borough and its subordinate entities, if any, do not reasonably anticipate issuing in excess of \$10 million of new money tax-exempt obligations (other than private activity bonds) during the calendar year 2019.

SECTION 5. It is further determined and stated that the Borough has not, as of the date hereof, issued any tax exempt obligations (other than the Note) during the calendar year 2019.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. The Borough will, to the best of its ability, attempt to comply with respect to the limitations on issuance of tax-exempt obligations pursuant to Section 265(b)(3) -4- of the Code; however, said Borough does not covenant to do so, and hereby expressly states that a covenant is not made hereby.

SECTION 7. The issuing officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to deliver a certified copy of this resolution to the original purchaser of the Note and to further provide such original purchaser with a certificate of obligations issued during the calendar year 2019 dated as of the date of delivery of the Note.

SECTION 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
