REPORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY

Councilmember Fenwick: Finance Committee: We had a Finance Committee meeting this morning. Attendees were: Mayor Misciagna, Councilmember Robert Metzdorf, our new Temporary CFO Richard Wright, Jeff Bliss, Julie Falkenstern, Jessica Mazzarella. As the Mayor already noted, we could not have a vote on the Budget tonight as the State has not yet finished reviewing the Budget as a requirement of us voting on the Budget. Memorial Day: The American Legion will be holding a ceremony in town. Councilmember Metzdorf is on that committee and will be speaking more about that later in his report.

Councilmember Ferguson: Pool: I would like to announce that the Pool will be opening this weekend - which is fantastic! They did a great job opening up last year, but it seems this year will be bigger and better. PKRG-TV News: PKRG is currently in production on a PSA, "Get Vaccinated" which is designed to encourage our local community residents to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. It features Dr. William Moss of John Hopkin's University as well as several local health experts. PKRG-TV is also in production of Episode 4 of the Actors Showcase Program and is in post-production of Episode 10 of What's Cooking Park Ridge with award-winning Chef, Michael Marita of Rocking Ruth's Restaurant.

<u>Councilmember Cozzi</u>: Library: We had another very positive meeting with the Library Committee. They are now open from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and open 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday and Thursday. They are now allowing 5-10 people into the Library, for up to 30 minutes, and are allowing people to use the 2 computers they have in there at 30-minute clips. They are also allowing people to come in and read the newspapers and the public restrooms have now been opened as well.

So, the Library is slowing creeping towards a full-on opening of the Library and I look forward to hopefully telling you that the next time we meet.

Councilmember Metzdorf: Access For All Committee: I am proud to say that the Access For All Committee finally met for the first time in 2021. The committee came back and they are very happy with what the town has done with, up till now. They had no new things that they requested of the town, because we have fulfilled all their needs and obligations as of now. Tri-Boro Food Pantry: The summer months are upon us, or soon will be, and traditionally people drop off less donations during the summer months. With the COVID-19 still affecting a lot of people economically, I ask that we consider dropping off any extra donations you have that can help these people in need. American Legion: On Monday, the American Legion will be having a Memorial Day presentation at Veteran's Park at 10:00 a.m. All town people are invited - this is a day we can repay respect for all those deceased members of the Armed Forces of the United States - people who paid the ultimate sacrifice. It is something that we can all do to remind ourselves how valuable these men and woman were. We will be reading off all of the names of all the Park Ridge residents who have provided the ultimate sacrifice. Once again, Memorial Day is a day where people have a 3-day weekend, but Memorial Day is set aside so that we can honor these men and woman who gave the ultimate sacrifice. I ask anybody who has the time to be there, we will be there at 10:00 a.m. We will be socially distanced even though the Governor has said we can have large groups. A lot of the people there will be elderly, so we do request that you maintain some socially distance so we can all remain healthy while honoring these people of Park Ridge.

<u>Mayor Misciagna</u>: I encourage everyone to go down to the Memorial Day Service, as well. I am excited to be part of history in Park Ridge – in the 127 years that Park Ridge has been incorporated, Kelly was the first woman to be in charge of a Mayor & Council meeting.
