ADOPTING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE POLICY FOR EMPLOYERS

WHEREAS, the purpose of the State of New Jersey Domestic Violence Policy for Public Employers is to set forth a uniform domestic violence policy for all public employers to adopt in accordance with N.J.S.A. 11A:2-6a.; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this policy is also to encourage employees who are victims of domestic violence, and those impacted by domestic violence, to seek assistance from their human resources officers and provide a standard for human resources officers to follow when responding to employees; and

WHEREAS, all employees of Borough of Park Ridge are covered under this policy, including full and part time employees, casual/seasonal employees, interns, volunteers and temporary employees at any workplace location; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Park Ridge has designated employees as the Primary HRO and Secondary HRO, to assist employees who are victims of domestic violence. The designated Primary and Secondary HRO shall receive training on responding to and assisting employees who are domestic violence victims in accordance with this policy; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Park Ridge does hereby adopt the Borough's Domestic Violence Policy for Public Employers as described in the attached policy; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Borough shall distribute such policy to all employees by March 1, 2020; and
