TO MODIFY FLIGHT PATHS TO TETERBORO AIRPORT**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Park Ridge recognizes the serious negative impact on its residents resulting from the barrage of business jets flying overhead for arrival at Teterboro Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, the detrimental effect of low flying jets at high rates of speed with low altitudes often on a descending path, generating high pitched, loud, whistling and roaring engines degrades the quality of life for Borough residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body has received numerous calls and emails from citizens directly affected by the change in flight patterns, with Park Ridge neighborhoods increasingly affected by noise, light and air pollution from low-flying aircraft; and

**WHEREAS**, the flight patterns of jets arriving also impacts the tranquility and quality of life for residents in other municipalities and such flight paths rely on an Instrument Landing System (ILS), which system has lately guided upwards of 200 arriving business jets per day, often 30 during a busy hour, over the homes of residents in the path, generating unreasonably high levels of noise pollution; and

**REPORTS OF THE GOVERNING BODY**

**Councilmember Fenwick:** There has been no meeting of the Finance or Redevelopment Committees. However, we are proceeding with the Borough's insurance company, as well as FEMA, to get funding to fix the damage to our fields that we encountered with the most recent storm. Additionally, on the redevelopment front; some good news: Party City is looking at moving its' headquarters to Woodcliff Lake. I find that encouraging – it's always good to see large businesses moving into the Corporate Park areas in the Pascack Valley. So, I wholeheartedly encourage Party City to move into the Valley and it will certainly bring more jobs if they do so.

**Councilmember Ferguson:** PKRG has recently filmed a PSA called “Recycle This” which is designed to help residents to make the best use of our town’s recycling facility. So, look out for the PSA coming out this fall. Also, the PRAA is looking for volunteers in all facets of the organization. From trustees, to commissioners to coaches – so if anyone is interested, please go to parkridgeathletics.com or you can connect with myself, and I can point you in the right direction as to who to contact. It is always fun watching the little ones grow through sports. So, if you have the time, please volunteer.

**Councilmember Cozzi:** The Library Committee met very quickly and we are happy to report that there was no flooding of the Library this time around. There was no flooding as I learned at that meeting, due to the monitoring of the flood gates. And, so there was no issue with any flooding, the Library is fine and its open and ready for business. There was a vote to waive any types of fines for late books through the rest of the year. They are still using the book pick-up so if you want to take out books, they are still happily putting your books in bags or boxes for the books you would like to check out to read. However, they are still holding people to about 30 minutes inside the Library

**Councilmember Capilli:** The Police Department has been working with Operation Helping Hand which is a State-wide program to help combat opioid and heroin use. So, when people are unfortunately arrested by the police, the charges aren’t dropped, but they are offered a helping hand and pointed in the right direction and towards some treatment. A lot of Park Ridge people turned out and it was an honor to be there and watch all of these people honor the people who gave their lives that day. They are all in our heart and I think Park Ridge showed its true heart by its turn-out that day. Secondly, I would like to congratulate, a little prematurely, Alice Quackenbush, a Park Ridge resident, who will turn 100 on October 8th. That’s a big accomplishment. First of all, this Saturday, October 1st, we have the Oktoberfest which is back in Park Ridge. It will be held at the Elks Lodge on Sulak Lane from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. It is a family-friendly event that will have games and things to do with the kids, as well as beer garden and German-themed foods so it should be a good time so you should definitely stop over there. Proceeds will be going to the Elks and their charity organizations. On Saturday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, we will have the Ragamuffin Parade – once again - back in action. It will be slightly different this year due to the Memorial Field issues. Gather at the Train Station at Depot Square Station by 12:00 p.m. and we will march on down to the High School Football Field, led for the first time this year, by the High School Marching Band. Down at the field, the kids will march a lap around the field, there will be treats for the kids, a D.J., Halloween costume recognition and possibly even an ice cream truck. I will always acknowledge his passing and his birthday when that happens in the spring. I would like everybody to think about him and also the Barker and Lewis Families – the cornerstones to our community – and they are still here. I think everybody knows Dolly (nee Barker) Lewis – she is beloved by the community. She was Jedh’s sister. I just want everybody to keep them in your thoughts during this month.
