Mayor Misciagna calls for a motion to suspend the regular order of business to administer the Oath of Office of Vahak Hanessian and Mark Soulas as new Park Ridge Volunteer Fire Department Members

A motion was made by Councilmember Metzdorf and seconded by Council President Epstein to confirm.

Mayor Misciagna invites Fire Commissioner John Ferguson and Fire Chief Tom Lepore to the Dais to administer the Oath of Office to Vahak Hanessian and Mark Soulas as new Park Ridge Volunteer Fire Department Members.

Park Ridge Volunteer Fire Chief Tom Lepore: Both of these members have been members of the Junior Cadet Program for the last 2 ½ years and we are very excited to have them move up into the ranks. Mark Soulas has already completed Firefighter 1 and is fully certified. Due to timing, Vahak Hanessian will be signed up in the next Firefighter 1 class, as it becomes available. We are really excited as a volunteer organization to have such 2 dedicated people to assist the borough and be part of the Park Ridge Volunteer Fire Department. Thank you!

AGENDA CHANGES: There are none.

PUBLIC PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR:

Mayor Misciagna asks if anyone present wishes to be heard on any matter.

Upon recognition by the Mayor, the person shall proceed to the floor and give his/her name and address in an audible tone of voice for the records. Unless further time is granted by the Council, <u>he/she shall limit his/her statement to five (5) minutes</u>. Statements shall be addressed to the Council as a body and not to any member thereof. No person, other than the person having the floor, shall be permitted to enter into any discussion, without recognition by the Mayor.

Speaker #1 Ralph Donnell - 31 Victor Hugo Street - I would like to thank the Mayor & Council for putting the Open Space Initiative on the Ballot, on November 2nd. There is a group of us that will work very hard to, hopefully, get it approved by the public, in Park Ridge, as we did five years ago. In review – go back five years: Prior to being approved in 2016, we put the Initiative up, you put it up, and it was turned down 3 times. So, at that point, there was a group of us (Keith and Julie you were both involved) that decided we had to go out and sell this to the public. A group of us, with our own money, did several things: 1- We contracted with the Trust for Public Land to do a survey of the residents of Park Ridge. They did a telephone survey and then in January, 2016 they wrote this report. They found that there was a lot of support for open space, once they understood what open space was all about. The problem was that people didn't realize that we were being taxed without representation. Everyone in Park Ridge, along with all of you up here, you know we have an Open Space Bergen County tax. We pay that - we cannot tap into that, unless we have our own. For six years, we did not have our own. Our money was going to other towns and that angered a group of us. So, what we did was, we took our own money, step #1 was to get this report and step #2 we went out there and we sold the Open Space Initiative to the public of Park Ridge. We bought lawn signs, and I just want you to know that they have already been ordered for this year; (Borough Administrator Julie Falkenstern announced that they are here). We put a banner over Park Avenue (paid for out of our own money), we developed a flyer (out of our own money) and a group of us went to different groups within the town. We visited and did a presentation to the Senior Citizens, the Atrium (now Springhill), the American Legion and to Bear's Nest. Everyone was shocked that they were paying a tax and we were getting nothing in return. And when they heard that, they said we will be voting "Yes". And that was *overwhelmingly* supported by the Park Ridge taxpayers. Nobody likes the word "tax". I would like to thank you. My biggest disappointment that you put a "Sunset" clause in there. That's another issue that's "water under the bridge". I also want to encourage you, you may or you may not know, that open space funds can be used for historic preservation. I want to encourage you, the members of the Council, when you are allocating those funds, that you seriously consider spending some of that money, if we can get money from Bergen County to match that, to complete the restoration of our Train Station. The Mayor and Borough Administrator know that I have been after this for six years and I am not giving up. Recently, both Keith and Julie, and Joe and myself, as we have done almost every year, went up to the Train Station and made a punch list of all that needed to be done – as well as things that we would love to see be done. That Train Station is a symbol of this town. You see it on Borough publications, on Facebook, you see it all the time. The Park Ridge Magazine that comes out, the Train Station is there.

Now, I want to encourage members of the Council, if you haven't walked up there - if you haven't parked up there and gotten out of your car - to walk around that Train Station and inside to see the condition of it. Back in 1980 and 1981, it was restored by the residents of Park Ridge. It has deteriorated greatly since then and it is in terrible condition. Thank you, Julie (Borough Administrator) and Keith (Mayor) for getting a Grant to replace the windows. That is the progress that we made in six years – replacement of the windows. I was celebrating that day as I was down there when they were installing them. That was progress – we need to make more progress! I believe that the residents of Park Ridge, this town, deserve to have that Train Station restored to its former glory. The commuters that use that station, deserve it – and with the "James" and other developments, you know we will have more commuters, as things roll out from this Pandemic. So, I want to encourage you to use some of those funds to restore the Train Station. If you haven't gone up to 19 Ridge Avenue, the Pascack Historical Society, and have seen the new Exhibit on the development of the Pascack Valley - in relation to the trains. It is a great Exhibit, and unfortunately, it closes this Sunday. Please come and see it. A couple of things from that - #1 you will see that there are only two train stations in the Pascack Valley that are original and historic. We have one of them... the Park Ridge one – up at Depot Square. the other is in Hillsdale. It's a shame that we have not been good custodians of that building. #2, the Historical Society saved two of those windows that were removed. And, one of the displays is one of the windows – and behind that is a photograph that has been blown up, that if you were in that train station back in the late 1800's, that this is what you would see of Depot Square. I think it is very dramatic to see that. Third thing is that all of the stations are represented up there. #3, that I think is interesting- most people do not know that there were two train stations in Hillsdale. There is also information about that as well – because I think that its very important to see why that train station was built, and why it no longer exists. Every other train station, in the Pascack Valley, from Emerson on up, has either been burnt down, torn down or has been so renovated - it has no historic matter left. So, please...thank you #1 for the Open Space Initiative, and please truly consider using open space funds for the restoration - and come see the Exhibit on Sunday before it closes. If you are a true history railroad buff, at 2:00 the Railroad Club of Bergen County is going to come and do a talk on the Pascack Valley line. I encourage everyone to come and see the Exhibit and if you are not members of the Historical Society, I encourage you to become members. You can pick up a form and join on Sunday when you come.

Mayor Misciagna: Ralph, I would like to thank you for everything you do for the town. You are the Borough Historian - you are the guy that pushes us to do what we all want to do. Sometimes we get off track, but I've already told you that we are committed to restoring the Train Station. Things have gotten away of that, but we will continue with that very soon. We are getting prices for different options and so on, so I want to thank you for that. The Open Space Initiative - I think you touched on exactly what everybody needs to hear. We are actually losing money if we do not have it. The money goes to other towns and we can use it, and we have been using it. You have been instrumental in getting a lot of important projects done; town beautification and more — and I want to thank you for that.

Ralph Donnell: That's 12 years of history of the Open Space Committee and we hope we can continue.

Mayor Misciagna: I want you to know that I am a member of the Pascack Historical Society. I think it is important that everybody join. The membership cost is \$25.00 for a single and \$40.00 for a family. One important fact is that it houses the Wampum machine, the last Wampum machine in the country. The Smithsonian every year asks for it and we have it here – it's a very valuable, historical piece of equipment. The Campbell Brothers were very instrumental in the forming of our nation when it was beginning. I want to thank you and I promise you that we will continue with the Train Station and I will do my part to get the Open Space tax passed, if I can. For those that don't know who Eric Johnson is, he is a Harvard graduate and now has his PhD. A couple of years ago he contacted us – he was doing his PhD on the Campbell Brothers and their significance to the fledgling United States and how important the Wampum machine was. His thesis was based on Park Ridge – it was wonderful! I would love to see him come back and do a lecture series. We would welcome him to one day come back and speak with all those interested in hearing all about this important history.
