Councilmember Cozzi: The library committee met, and we have a new member, Tatiana Breslow, she is also on the Board of Health. We spoke about the three iPad the library will be getting from the state which are incorporated to the whole library cooperative system, BCCLS. These can be taken out and used in ten different languages. The one strength is that people can do tele doctor visits. They are in sealed carriers and have protected security to make sure they are returned. Regarding the book pickups, it has been so successful that it will continue post COVID. Spring will start up with outside story time for children. Masks will be optional.

I am grateful for the whole committee; it amazes me how many hours and skills and expertise they put into it. There was a meeting of the access for all committee attended by Lt. Mauro, myself and Brittany Vozza of the Vozza Agency. Brittney brought up to the Lt. a problem with one of the traffic lights in town more so on the Montvale side, but the Lt. look into the issue and see if he can have them fix it. The police in town have noticed that bicyclist are not wearing a helmet, children up to the age of 18 have to wear a helmet. The police would like to advise the parents to have their children wear a helmet. Lt. Mauro will be doing a public service message through the access committee and hopeful Dairy Queen and Burger King will provide incentives for children to wear the helmet.


